ISSUE 18: CAKE THAT | PIN WHEEL TEMPLATE

1. Cut out a square of paper to the size of your liking. Fold diagonally to find the centre and punch a small hole, large enough to hold the brads of your choice. Trim along the fold marks towards the centre, stopping approximately 10mm from the centre. Punch small holes in the corner of each section as indicated. Repeat for all sides.
2. Fold in one corner of each triangle towards the centre hole.
3. Position your brad through the centre, securing all four triangles.
4. Once the brad is in position use the pointed ends (on the reverse side) to secure the completed pinwheel into cake icing or slot into a pre-drilled hole in wooden sticks and secure with a dollop of fast setting, clear glue such as Selley's Aquadhere, available from hardware stores.
