ISSUE 19: JUST MY TYPE | NOTECARD TEMPLATE

1. Using the second page of the pdf, print out as many notecards as you would like, on to the heaviest weight paper that is compatible with your printer.
2. Using a sharp cutting knife, use the trim marks as a guide to cut each notecard to size.
3. Leave a stack of blank notecards with pens for guest to write a lasting comment for the couple. Hang them from string or twine with folding clips, available to purchase in a variety of sizes from OFFICEWORKS.COM.AU.

ISSUE 19: JUST MY TYPE | ENVELOPE TEMPLATE

1. Print out the following page on to A3 sized paper of your choice. We used Kraft paper for ours.
2. Using the dashed lines, using a scoring or envelope folding tool (available from art supplies stores) to crease the paper where it will be folded.
3. With sharp scissors, or scalpel blade trim around the envelope shape, ensuring you cut on the inside of the black line so it isn't left on the final envelope.
4. Fold each panel along the score lines made.
5. Punch holes as indicated by the small crosshairs and finish with a small metal rivet if you choose.
6. Using double-sided tape, seal each side of the folded envelope.
7. Use a complementary twine, wound around the rivets to seal the envelope.
